System Requirements

- Windows 11 (64-bit)
- Windows 10 (64-bit/ 32-bit)
- Windows 8.1/ 8 (64-bit/ 32-bit)
- Windows 7 (64-bit/ 32-bit)

Important

• Disable your Antivirus or Security software to prevent interference during the installation process

Steps

1. Download DupInOut Duplicate Finder from the official website:

https://www.dupinout.com/

2. After the download finishes, double-click on the **DupInOut_Setup.exe** file.



3. A User Account Control (UAC) prompt will appear. Click on Yes.



4. <u>If your computer doesn't have the required Microsoft .NET</u> <u>Framework installed</u>, you'll get a similar message box:



Click on **OK**.

The Setup will open the official page to download the relevant version of Microsoft .NET Framework.

Download and install it.

Re-open the **DupInOut_Setup.exe** file.

Click on **Yes** in the UAC prompt.

5. The Setup will now open. Click on **Next** in the welcome page.



6. Read the End User License Agreement (EULA). If you agree, select **I accept the agreement**, and then click on **Next**.
